Any HEADING is for reference only and has no regulatory effect.

1. DEFINITION

A single-seater racing cars of free design, complying with the Technical Appendix in the Motorsport Australia Manual, and with the general requirements of and the Circuit Race Appendix. 1st Category – Racing Cars, except as permitted allowed below.

Note: Regulations for a specific speed event may preclude the use of The Track Licence may prevent Formula Libre Automobiles or open-wheel racing cars-from competing.

2. CLASSES

The use of existing record classes is permitted for Formula Libre <u>Automobiles</u> cars in Speed Events.

3. FUEL

Fuel must comply with is free, save for that which is specifically prohibited (refer Technical Appendix, Schedule G in the Metersport Australia Manual).

4. TRANSMISSION

Four-wheel drive is permitted in Speed Events.

Unless specifically-required in Supplementary Regulations, an operable reverse gear and on-board starter are not required.
