# **Duties and Responsibilities**

### **Club and Venue Development**

- Work with affiliated clubs to help them strengthen their membership base and overall functionality
- Assist clubs in identifying their needs and developing and implementing strategies to meet those needs and identifying sources of funding.
- Develop community and club relationships and partnerships.
- Develop and grow affiliated club network within the region.
- Grow the number of Motorsport Australia permitted events within the region.
- Attend State Council meetings to identify areas for support and opportunity.
- Provide support to clubs and help increase the take up of Motorsport Australia systems and participation offerings

# **Sport Development**

- Manage and maximise relationships with tracks/venues to ensure that they maintain their compliance and maximise the usage of Motorsport Australia products
- Represent and build the profile of Motorsport Australia at local motorsport events.
- Identify emerging trends in sport and motorsport and develop commercial opportunities to increase revenue and community participation.

### General

Assist in the procurement of government grant opportunities.



- Manage key relationships, funding applications, contractual agreements and acquittals with state government bodies.
- Report on progress and measure growth in participation.
- · Assist with ad-hoc project roll outs.
- · Other duties as assigned.
- Comply with all occupational health and safety legislation and regulations.
